Dear Mr. Wohlforth:

Thank you for your letter of June 18 and the enclosed copy of your letter to the Banque Populaire Suisse, of April 16.

The difficulty has arisen because, in spite of the fact that your check was airmailed on April 16 to the bank, Miss Faiman, to whose account this was sent, informed us on June 14 that as of June 10 the money had still not been credited to her account. Miss Faiman is now in Israel, and we have cabled her after receiving your cable to check again. So far, we have had no reply from her.

I should therefore like to urge you to cable the bank directly and ask whether they received your check No. 246 of April 15 and, if so, ask them to cable Miss Faiman at the following address: c/o Altman, 3 Gordon Street, Tel Aviv. In case the Banque Populaire Suisse informs you that the money has not been received, I should like to ask you to cancel your check immediately and issue a new one for the entire sum to be sent to me, at 30 rue la Boetie, Paris 8.

If I hear from Miss Faiman that the bank in Geneva has confirmed receipt of your check I shall cable you immediately.

I regret all these complications, but it is necessary to clear up this matter as quickly as possible, for the person for whom this sum is intended is in great financial need.
